Where Bilateral (2.5 GPA)

Four country options for UNIQUE courses:

- Australia: MANY, Full year, fall (leave June) and/or winter (leave late Feb/March)
- Belize: University of Belize, Fall, Winter, Full year
- Sweden: Halmstad Univ. Full year, winter semester
- UK: UHI Millennium, Anytime, modules (similar to NRS cohort)
